



OSU Satellite Dish Installation

In September 2011, a new satellite dish was installed at Oregon State University to replace a faulty system. This dish tracks and receives data from 7 different satellites as they pass overhead.



Real-time satellite data provide critical information during natural hazards such as fires. This system enables the continuation of 10 years of monitoring for the west coast, plus the collection of data from newer satellites.
