OSU Real-Time Satellite Data



Satellite data from 7 satellites are collected in real-time as they pass overhead. The data from two ocean color sensors (MODIS and VIIRS) are made freely available online. An agreement between NASA/NOAA & ISRO for OSU to receive OCM-2 data is pending.



Real-time satellite data provide critical information during hazards such as fires and oil spills. These data provide a continuation of 10 years of monitoring of the west coast.
